

## Climate award to Swedish shipping company

Terntank Ship Management has received Global Game Changer Award 2019 for contributing to a low carbon model for shipping. The owners Tryggve Möller, Annika Kristensson and Rigmor Möller received the award Wednesday at the company office on Donsö island.

“Terntank and the Donsö island shipping operators are showing a leadership the world needs”, says Jan Rapp, MD and founder of Biogas Academy. The Gothenburg region is a global leader in using biomethane as fuel in road transport. By accepting higher costs in the acquisition of new, more technically advanced vessels, the local shipping operators make it possible to use the same fuel offshore.

In different parts of the world, environmental and climate impact from heavy duty vehicles and buses are reduced using biomethane, a Swedish practise since 20 years. In 2018, Gothenburg took the next step by enabling biomethane fueled shipping. Thanks to the shipping families on nearby Donsö island, the Gothenburg region is the first in the world reducing climate impact from sea transport by using biogas.
